Notes: In the choral arrangement, the first chorus and verse are split between the men and ladies. The second verse falls to the ladies while the third is taken by the men. All song on the fourth verse. In the final chorus, the melody is taken in the tenor part while the sopranos sing a descant: the sopranos could alternatively be split between the melody (with the tenors) and the descant.

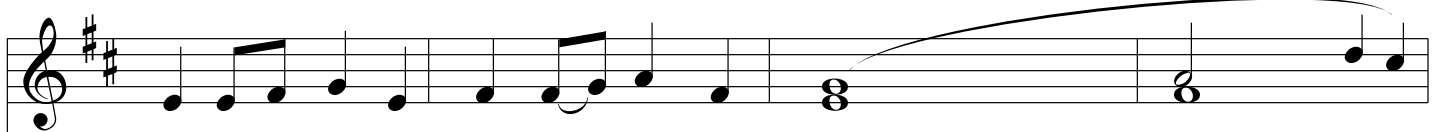

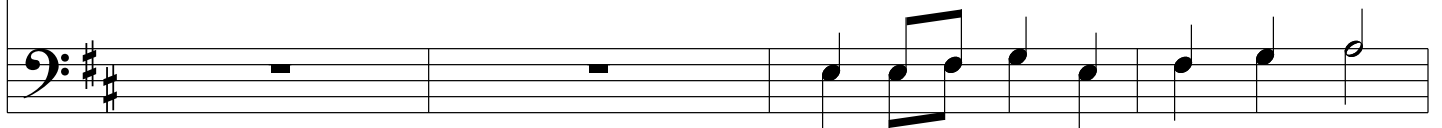

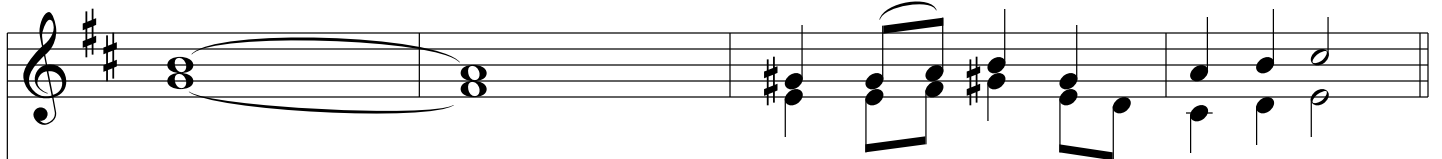
